1 The Supervisory Board

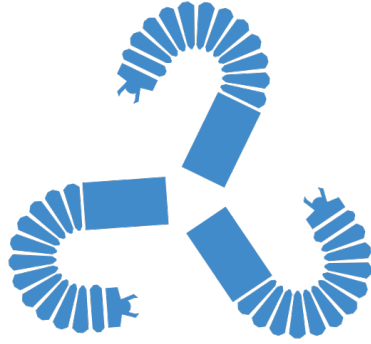
